The Holy Father wrote Patris corde against the backdrop of the Covid-19 pandemic, which, he says, has helped us see more clearly the importance of "ordinary" people who, though far from the limelight, exercise patience and offer hope every day. In this, they resemble Saint Joseph, "the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence," who nonetheless played "an incomparable role in the history of salvation."

FIRST STEP OPTIONS ... Surprise!! Pregnancies still happen during pandemics!!!

The COVID-19 pandemic has been hard on the First Step Options Pregnancy Resource Centre in Pembroke. Their biggest challenge is the reduction in revenue because they can't hold fundraising events. They do not receive government funding and raise all funds through churches, individuals and fundraising events.

First Step Options is a registered Christian charity which offers free pregnancy tests along with information about pregnancy options, and support by trained support workers, during and after pregnancy, including reproductive grief recovery for situations of stillbirth, miscarriage and abortion.



Among other things, it helps with material supports like diapers, formula, clothing and baby equipment. Last year, the Centre gave out \$3,000 in diapers and formula alone.
